This year the Organising Committee of the Sulhamstead & Ufton Nervet Fete felt that now was the time to separate the Sulhamstead & Ufton Nervet Produce Show from the annual Fete and hold it in the SUN Village Hall on 15 July 2018 with the set up carried out on 14 July.

Our thanks to those people who have supported the Produce Show and we look forward to your continued support in 2018. We would confirm that entries from surrounding areas, not just Sulhamstead and Ufton Nervet, are very welcome.

Please read the schedule carefully and see what you can produce for the show. We are not looking for exhibition quality exhibits, simply the best that you can do. Remember, if you are having a problem growing particular things it is almost certain that everyone else is experiencing the same problems.

Do not be shy if you have never entered before - there is a first time for everything!

We sincerely hope that the holding of the Produce Show in July will encourage many of you to participate and we look forward to seeing you on the day.

Finally, a special plea to parents and grandparents - there are some special classes for those members of the community under 15 years old and we hope that you will encourage your offspring and their friends to come along and enter, entry is free in the Junior Classes.

Prizes

Entry fee of 50p for each exhibit, and children's entries are free. Cash Prizes will be awarded in all Classes on the following basis:-

1st = £1 2nd = 50p 3rd = Highly Commended



RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY CONTD

REMOVAL OF EXHIBITS

12. No Exhibit may be removed until 4.00 pm after which all Exhibits should be collected as soon as possible. All Exhibits remaining after 4.30 pm will be regarded as gifts to the Fete and be sold on its behalf.

JUDGING

- 13. Except for Officials and other authorised individuals, no person will be allowed in the Show Areas while judging is taking place between 9.00am-11am.
- 14. Points will be awarded as follows for placings:

 1st—3 Points 2nd—2 Points Highly Commended—1 Point

 In the event of a tie, the Exhibitor who has gained the most 1st Places will be judged the winner.
- 15. The Judges may withhold Prizes where they consider the Exhibit does not merit a particular Award. The Judge's decision is final.

AWARDS, PRIZES and RESULTS

- 16. Money and other Supplementary Prizes will be presented in the Village Hall AFTER 3.00pm.
- 17. Any Trophies awarded remain the property of the Organisers and are to be held by the winners for one year only, and must be returned in the same condition to the Show Secretary in time for the Produce Show the following year.



RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY PRODUCE SHOW

Please read these RULES carefully to ensure that your entries comply and do not run the risk of being disqualified.

GENERAL

- The Special Rules for Divisions and any Exhibitors' Notes contained in the body of the Schedule shall be deemed to be a corporate part of these Rules and Conditions.
- 2. The Sulhamstead & Ufton Nervet PCC do not accept any responsibility for loss of or damage to any Exhibit.

ENTRIES & STAGING

- 3. Entries will only be accepted at the Village Hall between 2pm and 4pm on Saturday 14 July 2018
- Each entry must be accompanied by an Entry/Exhibition Label fully completed on both sides - a supply is included with this schedule.
- 5. The Entry Fee for each Adult exhibit is **50p** which must be paid at the time of entry. Junior Class entries are **Free**.
- 6. Each Exhibitor will be responsible for fixing the Entry/Exhibition Label to the Exhibit after staging.
- 7. No Exhibitor shall enter more than one Exhibit in the same Class.
- 8. In Classes 1-23 inclusive, Husband and Wife may exhibit from the same garden but **NOT** in the same Class.
- 9. In Classes 24-57 inclusive, Members of the same family may exhibit in the same Class.
- 10. **ALL** Flowers, Vegetables and Fruit shown must have been grown by the Exhibitor.
- 11. Vases or suitable stands will **NOT** be supplied by the Organisers for Classes 12 to 18 inclusive and Exhibitors must provide their own vases or containers for the Classes. The Vase or Container **WILL NOT BE JUDGED AS PART OF THE EXHIBIT**.



DIVISION A - VEGETABLE AND FRUIT CLASSES

- 1. 3 kinds of Vegetables—2 specimens of each. *Display to occupy an area not exceeding 45 cm wide and 60 cm deep.*
- 2. 3 sticks of Rhubarb
- 3. 3 Courgettes
- 4. 5 Runner Beans
- 5. 4 Tomatoes, standard size of one kind with calyx
- 6. Dish of 8 Cherry Tomatoes of one kind with calyx
- 7. Dish of 3 maincrop onions of one kind
- 8. Dish of one kind of any other vegetable (i.e. other than courgettes, runner beans, tomatoes, maincrop onions)
- 9. Dish of 2 kinds of Salad Vegetables (2 of each kind).
- 10. Dish of one kind of berry. Number optional. Stalks optional.
- 11. 3 strigs of currants of one kind
- 12. Dish of one kind of any other fruit (i.e. other than berries or currants
- 13. Collection of 4 herbs in one vase—Judged for quality

DIVISION B - MIXED FLOWER CLASSES & FLORAL ART

- 14. Vase of Roses, 3 stalks (which may be single or multi-bloomed)
- 15. Vase of one kind of flower. 5 stalks (which may be single or multi-bloomed) Any variety
- 16. Vase of Perennials. 3 separate kinds 2 of each kind
- 17. Vase of Annuals. 3 separate kinds 2 of each kind
- 18. Vase of Dahlias. 3 Stems. Number of kinds optional
- 19. Vase of Foliage 3 kinds
- 20. A flower arrangement no larger than 30cm square or diameter

DIVISION C - POT PLANT CLASSES*

- 21. A fuschia
- 22. A geranium or perlagonium
- 23. Flowering Pot Plant, other Fuschia, Geranium or Perlagonium
- 24. A Cactus or Succulent
- 25. Foliage Pot Plant

^{*}Special rule for exhibitors in Division C: The maximum size of pot which is used for Classes in this Division in 25cm (10 inches) internal rim diameter.



DIVISION D - HANDICRAFT CLASSES

SPECIAL RULES FOR EXHIBITORS IN THIS DIVISION

All entries in Classes must have been completed within 12 months prior to the date of the Show and all items must not have been exhibited before at a SUN Fete Produce Show.

All forms of exhibitors' identification must be obscured on exhibits.

- 26. An item of tapestry or embroidery—please specify on the front of the entry if a kit has been used
- 27. A Hand Knitted or Crocheted garment for a child or adult.
- 28. A Piece of Handmade Jewellery.
- 29. A Hard Handmade article (wood, metal or plastic).
- 30. A Soft Handmade article. Max.size 120cmsx120cms (48"x48")

DIVISION E - CREATIVE CLASSES

All exhibits in the classes should be no larger than A3 including frame $(42cm \times 29.7 cms or 16.5 ins \times 11.7 ins)$.

- 31. Pencil Drawing— any subject.
- 32. Poem on any subject.
- 33. Piece of Calligraphy or artistic writing on any subject.

DIVISION F - CULINARY CLASSES

SPECIAL RULES FOR EXHIBITORS IN THIS DIVISION

- Read the Schedule carefully and ensure that you use the correct containers, where specified, or your entry may be excluded by the Judge.
- Where labels are required you should only use small, PLAIN print labels.
- Any dish containing nuts should be labelled accordingly (in case of allergy)
- Entries MUST be exhibited as stated in the schedule or as stated below:

Class 36 Mark label "Mild" or "Hot" and ensure lid is airtight. Classes 37,38,39 & 40 should be placed on a disposable plate (e.g. paper or plastic).

- 34. A Jar of Home-made Jam
- 35. A Jar of Home-made Marmalade
- 36. A Jar of Home-made Chutney
- 37. A Victoria Sandwich filled with jam only
- 38. A decorated cake. Decoration will be judged not cake
- 39. A Home-made loaf (any type)
- 40. 6 Scones—any type, sweet or savoury. *Judged for consistency, flavour and texture.*

DIVISION G - PHOTOGRAPHY CLASSES

SPECIAL RULES FOR EXHIBITORS IN THIS DIVISION

- Exhibits Must Not be captioned or otherwise marked so as to be readily identifiable as to the entrant.
- Except where otherwise specified photographs may be mounted or unmounted and the maximum dimensions of any photograph shall be up to A4 size. No frames.
- Photographs must not have been exhibited before at the SUN Fete Produce Show.
- The organisers will aim to display all exhibits vertically with pins on a board. The pin will enter the mount or other tag where supplied.
- 41. A coloured photograph entitled "Some thing Red"
- 42. A coloured photograph of an animal or bird or insect.
- 43. A Black & White photograph— Any subject
- 44. An Un-mounted "Standard" print Flower(s)
- 45. A coloured photograph entitled "Wet"
- 46. A photograph—portrait

DIVISION H - CHILDREN'S SECTION For any young person under the age of 15 at 15 July 2018

- 47. A photo of "My Favourite Place" up to A4 size, mounted or not
- 48. Make and present 6 Brownies on a plate
- 49. Draw or paint still life picture of a "Fruit Bowl"

Children up to and including 5 years at 15 July 2018

- 50. Decorate 4 biscuits. Decoration will be judged not biscuits
- 51. Design and make a Birthday card for your Best Friend
- 52. Draw or paint a picture of your choice.
- 53. Create your own "Friendly Robot" using junk, up to 30cm tall.

Children from the age of 6-10 Years at 15 July 2018

- 54. Decorate 4 cupcakes. *Decoration will be judged not cupcakes*
- 55. Draw or paint a picture of your Dream Bedroom
- 56. Photo of an animal/pet up to A4 size
- 57. Make an animal from vegetables

Young People from the age of 11-15 Years at 15 July 2018

- 58. Make and decorate a cake. The the theme should be "Summer"
- 59. A photograph you have taken on any subject up to A4 size
- 60. A drawing or painting of a "Bird in Flight" of any size up to A4
- 61. Make a handmade article of any kind in any type of material—hard or soft
