ENTRIES & STAGING

3. Entries will only be accepted at the Show Tent between 0830 and 1000 on the morning of the show – DON'T BE LATE!!!
4. Each entry must be accompanied by an Entry/Exhibition Label & fully completed on both sides - a supply is included with this schedule.
5. The Entry Fee for each Adult exhibit is 50p which must be paid at the time of entry. Junior Class entries are Free. We do not accept cheques, cards or gift alternatives ☺

DIVISION G - PHOTOGRAPHY CLASSES

SPECIAL RULES FOR EXHIBITORS IN THIS DIVISION

- ❖ Exhibits Must Not be captioned or otherwise marked so as to be readily identifiable as to the entrant.
- ❖ The organisers will aim to display all exhibits vertically by pins on a board. The pin will enter the mount or other tag where these are provided.
- ❖ Except where otherwise specified photographs may be mounted or unmounted and the maximum dimensions of any photograph shall be 12" x 10".
- ❖ Photographs must not have been exhibited before at the SUN Fete Produce Show.

41	A coloured photograph - Landscape
42	A coloured photograph— an animal or bird or insect
43	A Black & White photograph— Any Subject
44	An Un-mounted "Standard" print Tree(s), <i>print no larger than 7" x 5"</i>
45	A coloured photograph Favourite Pet.
46	A photograph - Black & White - A Building

DIVISION H – CHILDREN'S SECTION

For any young person under the age of 15 years at 4th September 2017

- ❖ Please display your items in a plain bowl no bigger than 30cm in diameter.

47	My salad Bowl – A selection of salad vegetables that you have grown. Should contain between 3 and 5 different types. <i>You can have up to 3 of each vegetable exhibited.</i>
48	My fruit bowl – A selection of fruit that you have grown. Should contain between 2 and 5 different types.

Children up to and including 5 years at 4th September 2017

Class	Description
49	Decorate 4 biscuits
50	Items in a Smartie Tube—how many can you fit in? <i>Please give a list (which may be written by an adult).</i>
51	Draw or paint a picture of your choice.
52	Create your own design using lego / duplo bricks or similar "a friendly alien" – no bigger than 50cm in any direction

Children from the age of 6-10 Years at 4th September 2017

Class	Description
53	Decorate 4 small cakes - decoration will be judged, not taste
54	Items in a match box - how many can you fit in? <i>Please give a list (which may be written by an adult).</i>
55	Draw or paint a picture of your choice.
56	Create your own design using lego bricks or similar "a space creature" – no bigger than 50cm in any direction
57	An animal made from vegetables.

Young People from the age of 11-15 Years at 4th September 2017

Class	Description
58	Make and decorate a cake. The theme should be "summer"
59	A photograph you have taken – any subject, any size up to A4.
60	A Drawing or painting of your choice. Any size up to A3
61	Create your own design using lego bricks or similar, lolly sticks or any hard modelling "a moving space vehicle for Mars exploration" – no bigger than 50cm in any direction

6. Each Exhibitor will be responsible for fixing the Entry/Exhibition label to the Exhibit after staging.

7. No Exhibitor shall enter more than one Exhibit in the same Class.

7a. There is no minimum or maximum age limit for any class **except** the junior classes where ages are set out in the schedule.

8. In Classes 1-23 inclusive, Husband and Wife may exhibit from the same garden but **NOT** in the same Class.

9. In Classes 24-57 inclusive, Members of the same family may exhibit in the same Class.

10. ALL Flowers, Vegetables and Fruit shown must have been grown by the Exhibitor.

11. Vases or suitable stands will **NOT** be supplied by the Organisers for Classes 12 to 18 inclusive and Exhibitors must provide their own vases or containers for the Classes. The Vase or Container **WILL NOT BE JUDGED AS PART OF THE EXHIBIT.**

EXHIBITS

12. No Exhibit may be removed until 3.00 pm after which all Exhibits should be collected as soon as possible. All Exhibits remaining after 3.30 pm will be regarded as gifts to the Fete and be sold on its behalf.

JUDGING

13. Except for Officials and other authorised individuals, no person will be allowed in the Show Tents while judging is taking place between 10 a.m. and 12 a.m.

14. Points will be awarded as follows for placings: 1st—3 Points 2nd—2 Points Highly commended—1 Points In the event of a tie, the Exhibitor who has gained the most 1st Places will be judged the winner.

15. The Judges may withhold Prizes where they consider the Exhibit does not merit a particular Award. The Judge's decision is final.

AWARDS, PRIZES and RESULTS

16. Money and other Supplementary Prizes may be collected from the Show Treasurer at the desk in the Produce Show Tent **AFTER** 3.00pm.

17. Any Trophies awarded remain the property of the Organisers and are to be held by the winners for one year only.

18. Any prize money **NOT** collected by 3.30pm will be considered to be a donation to the fete.

DIVISION A - VEGETABLE AND FRUIT CLASSES

Class	Description
1	3 kinds of Vegetables—2 specimens of each. <i>Display to occupy an area not exceeding 45 cm wide and 60 cm deep</i>
2	3 Courgettes
3	5 Runner Beans
4	5 Tomatoes - standard size of one kind
5	Dish of 9 Cherry Tomatoes of one kind
6	Dish of Sweet Peppers and/or Chillies, <i>Number of kinds optional but at least two of each kind</i>
7	Dish of one kind of any other vegetable (i.e. other than courgettes, runner beans, tomatoes, sweet peppers or chillies) <i>Number optional</i>
8	Dish of 2 kinds of Salad Vegetables (<i>2 of each kind</i>)
9	Dish of one kind of berry. <i>Number optional. Stalks optional</i>
10	Dish of 5 plums, gages or damsons. One kind
11	Dish of one kind of any other fruit (<i>i.e. other than berries, plums, gages or damsons</i>).
12	Collection of 4 herbs in one vase— <i>Judged for quality</i>

DIVISION B - MIXED FLOWER CLASSES & FLORAL ART

Class	Description
13	Vase of one kind of flower - 5 stalks (<i>which may be single or multi-bloomed</i>)
14	Vase of Perennials. 3 separate kinds - 2 of each kind
15	Vase of Annuals. 3 separate kinds - 2 of each kind
16	Vase of Dahlias. 5 Stems. <i>Number of kinds optional</i>
17	Vase of Foliage 3 kinds
18	A flower arrangement no larger than 12" (30cm) square or diameter

DIVISION C - POT PLANT CLASSES *

Class	Description
19	Pot of Begonias
20	An Orchid
21	Flowering Pot Plant, <i>other than Begonias or Orchids</i>
22	Pot of Cactus or Succulent
23	Foliage Pot Plant

***SPECIAL RULE FOR EXHIBITORS IN DIVISION C:** The maximum size of pot which is used for Classes in this Division is 10 inch (25 cm) internal rim diameter

DIVISION D - HANDICRAFT CLASSES

SPECIAL RULE FOR EXHIBITORS IN DIVISION D

- ❖ All entries in Classes must have been completed within 12 months prior to the date of the Show and all items must not have been exhibited before at a SUN Fete Produce Show.
- ❖ All forms of exhibitors' identification must be obscured on exhibits.

24	An item of tapestry or embroidery— <i>please specify on the front of the entry if a kit has been used</i>
25	A Hand Knitted or Crocheted garment for a child or adult
26	A Piece of Handmade Jewellery
27	A Hard Handmade article (wood, metal or plastic)
28	A Soft Handmade article — <i>Maximum size 120cms x 120cms (48 inches x 48 inches).</i>

DIVISION E - CREATIVE CLASSES

All exhibits in the classes should be no larger than A3 including frame (42cm x 29.7 cms or 16.5 ins x 11.7 ins).

30	Pencil Drawing— any subject
31	Poem on any subject
32	Piece of Calligraphy or artistic writing on any subject

DIVISION F - CULINARY CLASSES

SPECIAL RULES FOR EXHIBITORS IN THIS DIVISION

- ❖ Where labels are required you should only use small, PLAIN print labels.
- ❖ Preserves should be in a jar *no bigger* than 1Lb / 500g. Wax covers are not required.
- ❖ Any dish containing nuts should be labelled accordingly (in case of allergy)
- ❖ Entries **MUST** be exhibited as stated in the schedule or as stated below:
- ❖ Class 35 Mark label "Mild" or "Hot" and ensure lid is airtight.
- ❖ Classes 37, 38, 39 & 40 should be placed on a plain disposable plate (e.g. Paper or plastic).
